a) 15 children for children aged birth to 2 years.

### **7** Explanation and Additional Conditions

The Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 introduced on 27 February 2009, requires a maximum group size of 15 children for children aged birth to 2 years. Children First Learning Centres Pty Ltd has applied for a Temporary Standards Exemption to continue to operate the Latrobe Room at Nipperville Kindergarten and Nursery with up to 20 children aged 15 months to two years until 31 December 2009.
