No. 3 of 1930.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1929.

B it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910, as follows:—

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Recovery of Lands* short title and Ordinance 1930.

(2.) The *Recovery of Lands Ordinance* 1929, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance* 1929-1930.

2. The Schedule to the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance* 1929 is Amendment of amended by omitting from Forms A, B and D the words "on or" Schedule. (wherever occurring).
