THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 3 of 1930.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1929*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1930*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1929*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1929-1930*.

2. The Schedule to the *Recovery of Lands Ordinance 1929* is amended by omitting from Forms A, B and D the words "on or" (wherever occurring). Amendment of Schedule.
