

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 1 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Instruments Ordinances 1933.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Instruments Ordinance 1936*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Instruments Ordinances 1933* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Instruments Ordinance 1933-1936*.

2. Section fourteen of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“14.—(1.) A bill of sale may be discharged or partly discharged by a memorandum in accordance with the form set out in Part I. of the Third Schedule to this Ordinance, or to the like effect, endorsed on the bill of sale or copy thereof, held by the grantee or person claiming through him, acknowledging that the bill of sale has been or is discharged or, in case of part discharge, the extent to which it has been or is so discharged. Discharge of bill of sale.

“ (2.) If the Registrar is satisfied that the bill of sale or copy held by the grantee or person claiming through him cannot, for some good reason, be produced, a bill of sale may be discharged or partly discharged by a memorandum in accordance with the form set out in Part II. of the Third Schedule to this Ordinance, or to the like effect, acknowledging that the bill of sale has been or is discharged or, in case of a part discharge, the extent to which it has been or is so discharged.

“ (3.) The signature to any memorandum acknowledging any such discharge or part discharge shall be witnessed by a solicitor of the High Court or by a Justice of the Peace, or by a Commissioner for Declarations appointed under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1911-1922*.
