THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 37 of 1936.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Land Valuation Ordinance 1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Land Valuation Ordinance (No. 2) 1936*.

(2.) The *Land Valuation Ordinance 1936*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Land Valuation Ordinances 1936*.

2. Section seven of the *Lands Valuation Ordinance 1936* is amended by inserting in sub-section (10.) after the word "Minister", the words "by counsel or solicitor or". ^{Appeals by lessees.}
