(2.) The Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937.

2. After section four of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted :----

Penalty: Ten pounds.".
