AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Plant Discases* Short title and Ordinance (No. 2) 1938.
- (2.) Sub-section (3.) of section one of the *Plant Diseases* Ordinance 1938 is repealed.
- (3.) The *Plant Diseases Ordinance* 1934-1936, as amended by the *Plant Diseases Ordinance* 1938, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Ordinance* 1934-1938.
 - 2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Definitions.

- (a) by inserting before the definition of "Disease" the following definition:—
 - "'Director-General' means the Director-General of Works;"; and
- (b) by omitting the definitions of "Minister" and "Secretary".
