AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1943.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1944*.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1943* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1944*.

2. Section three B of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:— Trespassing on lawns and grassed areas.

“3B. A person shall not, without lawful excuse (proof whereof shall lie upon him) trespass, or deposit a bicycle or other article, upon any lawn or other grassed area in any of the public streets in or immediately adjoining the Shopping Centres at City, Kingston and Griffith.”.

3. Section three c of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “(deposited in contravention of sub-section (2.) of the last preceding section) on any lawn in any public place” and inserting in their stead the words “deposited on any lawn or other grassed area in contravention of the last preceding section”. Bicycles, &c. may be impounded.
