

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 5 of 1955.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Ordinance 1927-1954.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1955*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Ordinance 1927-1954* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1927-1955*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the definition of “Commissioner” the words “Commission of Police” and inserting in their stead the words “Chief Commissioner of Police”. Definition.

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.), before the word “Commissioner”, the word “Chief”. Establishment of Police Force.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting before the word “Commissioner” the word “Chief”. Schedule.
