TOBACCO ORDINANCE 1957.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Tobacco Ordinance 1957*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Tobacco Ordinance 1927-1938*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Tobacco Ordinance 1927-1957*.

2. Sections two, three, four, six, seven, eight, nine, eleven, twelve, twelve A, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen and eighteen of, and the Schedule to, the *Tobacco Ordinance 1927-1938* are repealed. Repeal.
