EDUCATION ORDINANCE 1958.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1958*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Education Ordinance 1937-1956*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1937-1958*.

2. Section five of the *Education Ordinance 1937-1956* is amended by omitting the definition of "the Court" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—^{Definitions.}

" 'the Court' has the same meaning as in the *Child Welfare Ordinance 1957*;"
