To amend the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1958*.

STOCK DISEASES ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1959*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1958*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1959*.

2. Section eleven of the *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933-1958* is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:— Offences.

“(c) except in pursuance of the written permission of an inspector and in accordance with the conditions specified in the permission, sells or offers for sale or purchases or receives for purchase any infected stock;”.
