AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Weights and Measures Ordinance*
1929-1937.

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ORDINANCE 1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Ordinance* 1959.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Weights and Measures Ordinance* 1929-1937† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Ordinance* 1929-1959.

2. Section three A of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“3A. Subject to this Ordinance, the Regulations under the Weights and Measures Act, 1915-1956 of the State of New South Wales, in force at the commencement of this section, shall, subject to such modifications, adaptations and exceptions as are prescribed, apply to the Territory.” Application of State Regulations.

3. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-section:— Appointment of Inspectors, &c.

“(2.) The Minister may authorize a person to exercise the powers and perform the functions of a Superintendent under the regulations.”

Inspector not to derive profit from making, adjusting or selling weights, measures or weighing instruments.

4. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "the appropriate fee prescribed by the First Schedule to this Ordinance" and inserting in their stead the words "the prescribed fee".

Fees for verifying and stamping.

5. Section thirty of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "those specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Ordinance" and inserting in their stead the words "as prescribed".

First Schedule.

6. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Fifth Schedule.

7. The Fifth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
