## THEATRES AND PUBLIC HALLS

## No. 6 of 1964.

## An Ordinance to amend the *Theatres and Public Halls* Ordinance 1928-1946.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Theatres and* Short title and citation. Public Halls Ordinance 1964.\*

- (2.) The Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1946,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1964.
- 2. Section twenty-seven of the Theatres and Public Halls Public Ordinance 1928-1946 is amended by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section: and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

on certain days.

- "(2.) The last preceding sub-section does not apply to-
  - (a) a public entertainment consisting of the screening of cinematograph films that commences to be held after eight o'clock in the evening on a Sunday: or
  - (b) a public entertainment or a public meeting—
    - (i) that is held for a charitable purpose or is of a religious, educational, cultural or sporting nature; and
    - (ii) the holding of which is authorized by the Minister by instrument in writing under his hand.".
