

## THEATRES AND PUBLIC HALLS

## No. 6 of 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1946*.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1964*.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1946*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1964*.

2. Section twenty-seven of the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1946* is amended by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

Public  
entertainments  
and meetings  
not to be held  
on certain days.

“(2.) The last preceding sub-section does not apply to—

(a) a public entertainment consisting of the screening of cinematograph films that commences to be held after eight o'clock in the evening on a Sunday; or

(b) a public entertainment or a public meeting—

(i) that is held for a charitable purpose or is of a religious, educational, cultural or sporting nature; and

(ii) the holding of which is authorized by the Minister by instrument in writing under his hand.”.
