

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES

No. 12 of 1967

An Ordinance to amend the *Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1966*.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Ordinance 1967*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1966*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1967*.

2. Section 29 of the *Weights and Measures Ordinance 1929-1966* is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words “or repaired” and inserting in their stead the words “, repaired or altered”; and

(b) by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

“(2.) The person who mends, repairs or alters the weight, measure or instrument shall destroy the existing stamp on the weight, measure or instrument.”.
