AGENTS ORDINANCE 1971

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Agents Ordinance 1971*.\* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Agents Ordinance 1968-1970*† as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Agents Ordinance 1968-1971*.

2. Section 9 of the *Agents Ordinance 1968-1970* is amended— Appointment of members of the Board and tenure.
- (a) by omitting from sub-section (3.) the word "seventy-one" and inserting in its stead the word "seventy-two";
  - (b) by omitting from sub-section (4.) the word "seventy-one" and inserting in its stead the word "seventy-two"; and
  - (c) by omitting from that sub-section the words "sub-section (10.) of this section" and inserting in their stead the words "sub-section (9.) of this section".
