INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1972*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Interpretation Ordinance 1967*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967-1972*.
