### AGENTS ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Agents Ordinance 1972*.<sup>\*</sup>

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Agents Ordinance 1968-1971*† as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Agents Ordinance 1968-1972*.

2. Section 9 of the *Agents Ordinance 1968-1971* is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (3.) the word “seventy-two” and inserting in its stead the word “seventy-three”; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (4.) the word “seventy-two” and inserting in its stead the word “seventy-three”.
