WATER RATES ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Water Rates Ordinance Short title 1973.*

and citation.

- (2) The Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1972, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1973.
- 2. Section 16 of the Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1972 is Quantity amended---

of water supplied a meter.

- (a) by omitting the word "For" and substituting the words through "(1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), for "; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—
 - "(2) Where water is supplied to a parcel of land through a meter constructed to record quantities in kilolitres, subsection (1) applies as if, in place of the recording shown on the meter at a reading of the meter, there were shown a recording of an equivalent quantity of water expressed in gallons."
- 3. Section 30 of the Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1972 in Evidence. amended--
 - (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Department of the Interior" and substituting the words "Department of the Capital Territory"; and
 - (v) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-section (3) the words "Department of the Interior" and substituting the words "Department of the Capital Territory".
