CONSUMER AFFAIRS ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs Ordinance (No. 2) 1973*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs Ordinances 1973*.

2. Section 16 of the *Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973* is amended by omitting sub-section (2). Protection of members of Council and Director and his staff.
