FILM CLASSIFICATION ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Film Classification Ordinance 1974*.*

(2) The *Film Classification Ordinance 1971-1972*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Film Classification Ordinance 1971-1974*.

2. Section 8 of the *Film Classification Ordinance 1971-1972* is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (2)(b) the words “six years” and substituting the words “two years”;
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (3) the words “six years” (wherever occurring) and substituting the words “two years”; and
- (c) by omitting from sub-section (4) the words “six years” (wherever occurring) and substituting the words “two years”.
