### LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title

2. Section 34 of the *Liquor Ordinance 1975*<sup>†</sup> is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section: Conditions  
for issue of  
Club Licence

“(2) Where, in respect of premises situated on land comprised in a lease granted by the Commonwealth, there is in force a General Licence, the Board shall not authorize the issue of a Club Licence to a club if the premises of the club are situated on that land.”.
