LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1979

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amend- Short title ment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1979.
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Legal Principal Practitioners Ordinance 1970.² Ordinance
- 3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting Admission as after paragraph (1) (aa) the following paragraph:

 Admission as barrister and solicitor
 - "(ab) he has been admitted to the degree of Bachelor of Legal Studies at The Macquarie University;".
- **4.** Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (4) (a) and substituting the following paragraphs:

 Entry into articles of clerkship
 - "(a) the applicant has the educational qualifications specified in sub-section 10 (1) for admission as a barrister and solicitor of the Court:
 - (aa) the applicant has become eligible for admission to—
 - (i) the degree of Bachelor of Laws at an Australian university; or
 - (ii) the degree of Bachelor of Legal Studies at The Macquarie University; or".
