ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1980

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Administration and Probate (Amendment) Ordinance 1980.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929.²

Commencement

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory by notice in the *Gazette*.

Official certificate or copy of grants and wills obtainable

4. Section 125B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "payable to the Registrar under this Ordinance" and substituting, "payable in accordance with the Schedule to the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court (Fees) Regulations, as in force from time to time under the Australian Capital Territory Supreme Court Act 1933.".

Repeal of Part X

5. Part X of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
