An Ordinance to amend the *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Standard Time and Summer Time (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

2. The *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*² is amended by adding at the end thereof the following section:

Extended daylight saving period for 1982

"7. This Ordinance has effect in relation to the period commencing at the hour of 2 o'clock in the morning by the mean time of the one hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude east of Greenwich, England, on 7 March 1982 and ending at the hour of 2 o'clock in the morning by the mean time of that meridian on 4 April 1982 as if the reference in the definition of 'daylight saving period' in section 3 to the month of March were a reference to the month of April."
