An Ordinance to amend the Pharmacy Ordinance 1931

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Pharmacy (Amendment) Ordinance* (No. 2) 1982.

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1931.²

Repeal of section 19

- 3. Section 19 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
- 4. After section 48 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:

Payment of prescribed fees

"49. Where a prescribed fee is payable under this Ordinance, the prescribed fee shall be paid to the Capital Territory Health Commission.".
