An Ordinance to amend the *Liquor Ordinance* 1975

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance* 1982.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Liquor Ordinance* 1975.²

Disallowance of amendment of Manual

3. Section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) "President" and substituting "Speaker";
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2) "President" and substituting "Speaker"; and
- (c) by omitting from sub-section (3) "President" and substituting "Speaker".

Fees for renewal of licences

4. Section 96 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (4) (k) "President" and substituting "Speaker".
