An Ordinance to amend the *Traffic Ordinance 1937*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Traffic Ordinance 1937*.²

Walking without due care, &c.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty and substituting the following penalty:

"Penalty: \$100."

Driver, &c., intoxicated

4. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of sub-section (1) and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty: \$1,000 or imprisonment for 6 months, or both.”.

Bicycles to be deposited in bicycle racks

5. Section 28A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the penalty set out at the foot of sub-section (1) and substituting the following penalty:

“Penalty: \$40.”.

Further amendments

6. The Principal Ordinance is amended as set out in the following table:

Provision	Amendment
Sub-section 25 (3)	Omit “Two hundred dollars or imprisonment for six months”, substitute “\$500”.
Section 40	Omit “Forty dollars”, substitute “\$100”.
Paragraph 41 (d)	Omit “Twenty dollars”, substitute “\$50”.
