## Standard Time and Summer Time (Amendment) Ordinance 1986

An Ordinance to amend the *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Standard Time and Summer Time (Amendment) Ordinance 1986*.<sup>1</sup>

### Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Standard Time and Summer Time Ordinance 1972*.<sup>2</sup>

### Interpretation

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting "calendar" before "year" (wherever occurring) in the definition of "daylight saving period"; and

(b) by omitting the definition of “year”.

4. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section substituted:

**Extended daylight saving period for 1986**

“7. This Ordinance has effect in relation to the period commencing at the hour of 2 o’clock in the morning by the mean time of the one hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude east of Greenwich, England, on 2 March 1986 and ending at the hour of 2 o’clock in the morning by the mean time of that meridian on 16 March 1986 as if the reference in the definition of ‘daylight saving period’ in section 3 to the first Sunday in the month of March were a reference to the third Sunday in that month.”.
