An Ordinance to amend the Lakes Ordinance 1976

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lakes (Amendment) Ordinance* 1988.

Restrictions on use of power boats

- 2. Section 27 of the *Lakes Ordinance 1976*² is amended—
- (a) by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsections:
 - "(1) Subject to this section, a person shall not be in charge or control of a power boat on a lake.
 - Penalty: (a) in the case of a natural person—\$1,000 or imprisonment for 6 months, or both; and

- (b) in the case of a body corporate—\$5,000.
- "(1A) Subject to this section, a person shall not be in a power boat on a lake.

Penalty: \$1,000.";

- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) "sub-section (1)" and substituting "subsection (1) or (1A)"; and
- (c) by omitting from subsection (3) "Sub-section (1) does" and substituting "Subsections (1) and (1A) do".
