### **Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Ordinance 1989**

An Ordinance to amend the *Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) Ordinance 1982*

#### **Short title**

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the *Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Ordinance 1989*.<sup>1</sup>

### **Commencement**

2. Section 3 shall be deemed to have commenced on 11 May 1989.

### **Rules of Court**

3. Section 307A of the *Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) Ordinance 1982*<sup>2</sup> is amended—

- (a) by omitting “*Workmen’s Compensation Ordinance 1951*” and substituting “*Workmen’s Compensation Act 1951* of the Territory”;
- (b) by omitting “that Ordinance” (wherever occurring) and substituting “that Act”; and
- (c) by adding at the end the following subsection:

“(2) The rules in force under the *Workmen’s Compensation Act 1951* of the Territory immediately before the commencement of this section continue in force on and after the commencement as if they had been made under subsection (1).”.
