Royal Canberra Hospital Bill 1990

A BILL

FOR

An Act to retain the Royal Canberra Hospital

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Royal Canberra Hospital Act 1990*.

5 **Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Interpretation

10 3. In this Act, "Royal Canberra Hospital" means the public hospital situated at Block 1 Section 55 at Acton which is operated by the Australian Capital Territory Community and Health Service.

Operation of Royal Canberra Hospital

15 4. The Royal Canberra Hospital shall be operated by the Australian Capital Territory Community and Health Service for the provision of

public hospital services to the people resident in or visiting the Australian Capital Territory and surrounding regions.

Facilities and services to be provided at Royal Canberra Hospital

5 **5.** The Royal Canberra Hospital shall contain facilities and provide services for the adequate provision of the medical services and support services listed in the Schedule.

Application to the Crown

6. This Act binds the Crown.

Standing

10 **7.** Any resident of the Territory may bring an action in a court of competent jurisdiction to enforce any right created by this Act.
