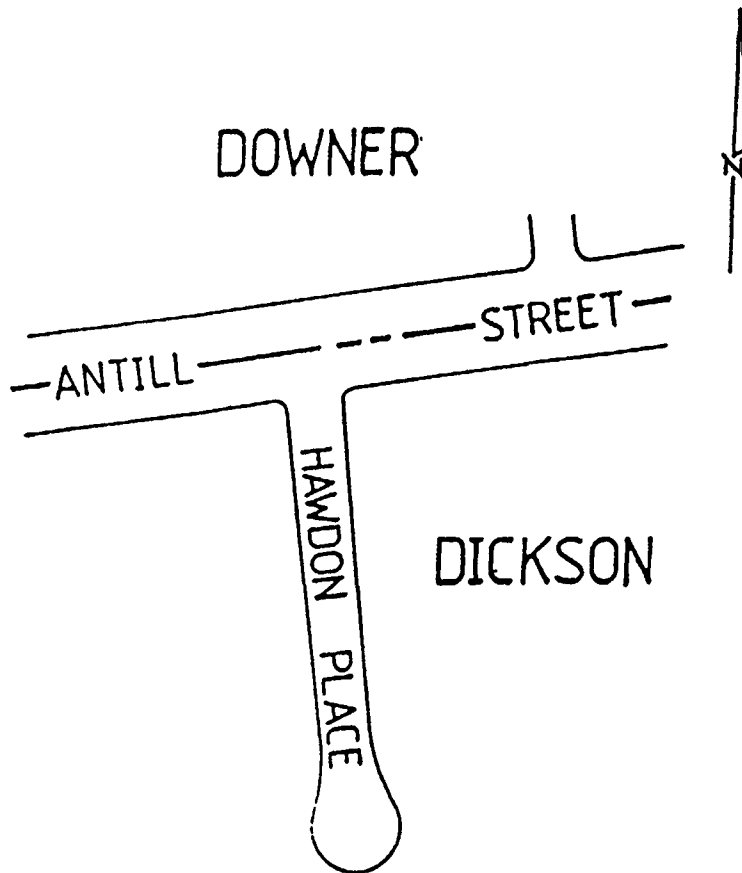

DIVISION OF PHILLIP THEME: NAMES ASSOCIATED WITH GOVERNOR PHILLIP AND 1ST, 2ND AND 3RD FLEETS: PHILLIP SUB-SECTION: SWINGER HILL - ARCHITECTS		
JESSUP PLACE	Francis Thomas JESSUP (1922-1976)	Architect; Fellow of the Royal Australian I n s t i t u t e o f Architects 1970. Responsible for many municipal projects, including several Canberra buildings and neighbourhoods.
DIVISION OF RICHARDSON THEME: NOTABLE WOMEN		
MARY McKILLOP PLACE	(Mother Mary Helen McKILLOP (1842-1909)	Best known as Mother Mary of the Cross. Founder of The Sisters of St Joseph, order of nuns devoted to the education and care of poor children.
ZADOW PLACE	Christiane Susanne ZADOW (1846-1896)	Trade Unionist and Factory Inspector. Worked to overcome the injustice of penurious wages of female workers in clothing factories; drew widespread support for female suffrage in South Australia.

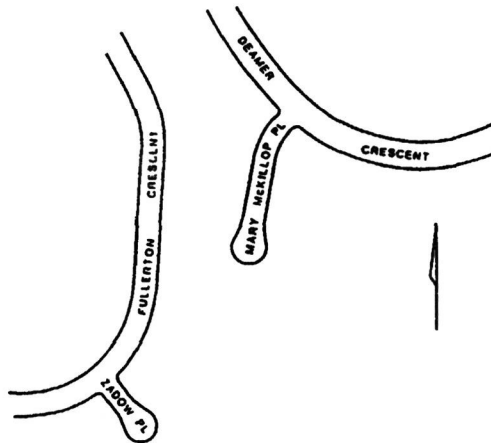
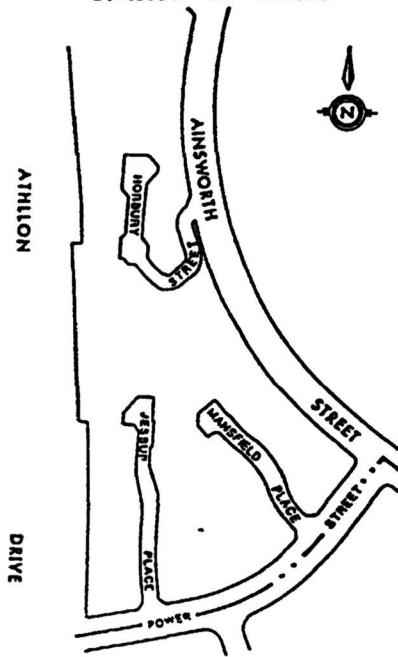


Division of DICKSON
