EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 9 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1989* establishes the Occupational Health and Safety Council

Section 13(1) of the Act provides that the Council shall consist of

- (a) 4 members appointed by the Minister after consultation with such persons or bodies as the Minister considers represent the interests of employees,
- (b) 4 members appointed by the Minister after consultation with such persons or bodies as the Minister considers represent the interests of employers, and
- (c) 4 other members appointed by the Minister.

Section 22(1) of the Act provides that the Minister may appoint a person to act as a member of the Council, other than the Chairperson or Deputy Chairperson

This Instrument appoints Robert Gotts as an acting member of the Occupational Health and Safety Council for a period of 3 years from the date of Gazetteal. This appointment has been referred to the Standing Committee on Social Policy, as required by the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, and the Committee has raised no objection to the appointment
