DETERMINATION OF FEES AND CHARGES

NO. 12 OF 1991

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Determination revokes the existing fees and charges determined under sections 14(1), 14(2), 59, 72 and 78 of the *Sale of Motor Vehicles Act 1977*.

This Determination sets new fees for the purpose of the issue and renewal of a licence to operate as a motor vehicle dealer in the ACT.

This Determination raises licensed dealers' contributions to the Motor Vehicle Dealers Compensation Fund from \$60 to \$300. This increase is necessary to cover the increased demand on the Fund arising from the default of licensed dealers who cease operation and are unable to meet their statutory obligations to consumers.

This Determination also sets fees for providing a copy of a motor Vehicle Dealer's Licence that has been lost or destroyed and for inspecting the Register of Motor Vehicle Dealers kept by the Registrar.
