## CASINO CONTROL ACT 1988

### DETERMINATION OF FEES

#### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

##### INSTRUMENT No. 14 of 2000

The *Casino Control Act 1988* (the Act) governs the operation and regulation of the Canberra casino. Section 132 of the Act allows the Minister to determine fees that relate to the purposes of the Act.

The Act was recently amended to allow for new fees to be charged for certain activities.

Specifically, a fee (unless waived) will need to accompany an application to the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission for the exclusion of a person from the casino as well as for the revocation of an exclusion notice. In addition, fees will now be payable to the Commission where the casino operator requests the Commission to declare a new game as an authorised game as well as for the Commission to approve an alteration to the rules of a game. The details of the new fees are outlined below:
