

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 3 of 1929.

AN ORDINANCE

Relating to the Leasing of Lands to the Council of the Municipality of Queanbeyan and to authorise the execution of Agreements in connexion therewith.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Queanbeyan Lease Ordinance* 1929. Short title.
2. In this Ordinance unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.
“the Commission” means the Federal Capital Commission;
“the Council” means the Council of the Municipality of Queanbeyan in the State of New South Wales;
“the lease” means the lease granted in pursuance of this Ordinance.
3. The Commission may grant to the Council a lease of any unleased lands. Power of Commission to grant lease.
4. The lease shall be— Terms and conditions of lease.
(a) for such period not exceeding ninety-nine years; and
(b) for such purposes and subject to such covenants and conditions as to rent and otherwise,
as the Commission determines.
5. The Council shall pay to the Commission such survey fee in respect of any land leased in pursuance of this Ordinance as is fixed by the Commission. Survey fee.
6. The Commission may execute such agreements as it deems necessary in connexion with the granting of the lease. Agreements.
