

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 3 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

**To provide for the appointment of an Administrator
of the Territory for the Seat of Government for
the purposes of the *Removal of Prisoners
(Territories) Act 1923.***

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the *Removal of Prisoners
(Territories) Act 1923* certain powers, functions and duties
relating to the removal of certain prisoners from a Territory to
a State or another Territory, there to undergo their sentences or
the residue thereof, are conferred on the administrators of Terri-
tories under the authority of the Commonwealth:

And whereas it is desirable that an Administrator of the
Territory for the Seat of Government be appointed for the
purposes of the said Act:

Be it therefore ordained by the Governor-General in and over
the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the
Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred
by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of
Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Removal of Prisoners* Short title.
Ordinance 1933.

2.—(1.) For the purposes of the *Removal of Prisoners (Terri-* Appointment
tories) Act 1923, there shall be an Administrator of the Territory, of Administrator
who shall be appointed by the Governor-General and shall hold for the purposes
office during his pleasure. of the Removal
of Prisoners
(Territories)
Act.

(2.) The Administrator, appointed in pursuance of this section
shall have, and may exercise or execute, in the Territory all the
powers, functions and duties of an Administrator under the
Removal of Prisoners (Territories) Act 1923.
