AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1932, as amended by the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1933.

E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Uni-Short title and citation versity College Ordinance 1936.
- (2.) The Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1932, as amended by the Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1933, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1936.
- 2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Functions of inserting after paragraph (c) the following paragraph:—

Jniversity

"(ca) to accept control of and manage any fund for the endowment of any scholarship, bursary or prize relating to education, upon the request of the person controlling or managing the fund;".
