No. 15 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1937.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra short title and Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1937.

(2.) The Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1936, as amended by the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1937, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Sub-section (3.) of section one of the Canberra Community

Hospital Board Ordinance 1937 is repealed.

- (4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1937.
- 2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—
- "7. A member of the medical staff or a medical practitioner Disqualification appointed to be a visiting medical officer or an honorary medical from membership of officer of the Hospital shall not be eligible for election as a member Board."
