No. 15 of 1937.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the **Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1937.**

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance (No. 2) 1937.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1936*, as amended by the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1937*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) Sub-section (3.) of section one of the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1937* is repealed.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Board Ordinance 1935-1937.*

2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“7. A member of the medical staff or a medical practitioner appointed to be a visiting medical officer or an honorary medical officer of the Hospital shall not be eligible for election as a member of the Board.” Disqualification from membership of Board.
