

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 12 of 1938.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Auctioneers Ordinance 1927-1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Auctioneers Ordinance 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Auctioneers Ordinance 1927-1936* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Auctioneers Ordinance 1927-1938*.

2. This Ordinance shall commence on a date to be fixed by the Minister by notice published in the *Gazette*. Commencement

3. Section six of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph (b) of sub-section (3.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:— Applications for licences.

“(b) is the holder of an auctioneer’s licence for the whole or part of the State in which he is resident.”; and

(b) by omitting sub-section (4.).

4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following proviso:— Grant or refusal of licences.

“Provided that a licence shall not be granted upon an application made in pursuance of sub-section (3.) of the last preceding section unless, under the laws of the State in which the applicant is resident, any resident of the Territory holding a licence under this Ordinance may obtain an auctioneer’s licence for the whole or part of that State.”.

5. Section twelve of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Repeal.

6. Section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (d) the words “a general” and inserting in their stead the word “an”. Cancellation or suspension of licence.

7. Section fourteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "three" (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word "seven".

Schedule.

8. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from Form AB the words "a general" and inserting in their stead the word "an".
