AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1939.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra Com-short title and munity Hospital Ordinance (No. 2) 1940.
- (2.) Section one of the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1940 is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).
- (3.) The Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1939, as amended by the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1940, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1940.
 - 2. Section twelve of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

Repeal of section twelve.

- 3.—(1.) Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is Meetings of amended by inserting in sub-section (2.), after the word "until", Board. the words "a Chairman is elected at the first meeting of the Board after".
- (2.) The amendment made by sub-section (1.) of this section shall apply in respect of the Chairman of the Board holding office at the date of the commencement of this Ordinance.
