AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Baths Ordinance 1940*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1940*.

2. Section seven of the *Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“7. The Minister may, for such period as he thinks fit, close any public baths or any part thereof at any time for cleansing or repairs or for any reason which he deems sufficient.”^{Closing of baths.}
