AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 3 of 1940.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1936.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra University College Ordinance 1940*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1936* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1940*.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "seven" and inserting in its stead the word "nine". The Council of the College.

3. Section six of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Members of Council how appointed.

(a) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "prescribed authority and two on the nomination of the";
and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (3.) the word "Three" and inserting in its stead the word "Five".
