AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1936.

B^E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1939, as follows:---

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Canberra short title and University College Ordinance 1940.

(2.) The Canberra University College Ordinance 1929-1936 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra University College Ordinance* 1929-1940.
