AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1940*, as amended by the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1941*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance (No. 2) 1941*.^{Short title and citation.}*

(2.) Section one of the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1941* is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(3.) The *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1940*, as amended by the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1941* and by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1941*.

2. Section ten of the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1940*, as amended by the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1941*, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following proviso:—^{Vacancy on Board—how filled.}

“Provided that, before making any such appointment, the Minister shall invite the Board to submit the names of three persons so qualified whom the Board deems suitable for appointment and, if the Board, within such time as is fixed by the Minister, submits the names of three persons so qualified accordingly, the person appointed by the Minister shall be one of those persons.”
