

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the **Liquor Ordinance 1942** and for other purposes.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Liquor Ordinance 1945*.
2. Section three of the *Liquor Ordinance 1942* is repealed.
3. The *Liquor Ordinance 1943* is repealed.
