## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1944.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1945*.\*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1944*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1945*.

2. Section three c of the *Police Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1944* is amended—

Former members of Police Force or Prisons Branch of the Public Service of the Northern Territory.

(a) by inserting in sub-section (1.), after the word “Force” (second occurring), the words “or of the Prisons Branch of the Public Service”; and

(b) by inserting in that sub-section, after the word “Force” (fourth occurring), the words “or Prisons Branch of the Public Service”.
